



A DAY IN SWAN VALLEY

Swan Valley is Australia's first Humane Food Region and is known as a food-lovers haven, underneath endless blue skies and surrounded by serene nature. Visitors are embraced with a homely feel by friendly hospitable locals. Take your time to discover this stunning region, relax in the country setting, see and taste some of the finest artisan goods in the world.

1. Caversham Wildlife Park (morning)

Only a 30-minute drive from Perth, you will be immersed in Perth's outback, spotting wild kangaroos along the way. Caversham Wildlife Park offers an interactive environment for the whole family to get up close to Australia's unique animals. Highlights include patting a koala, hand feeding kangaroos, watching animal feedings and an informative farm show of the Australian way of life.



2. Gourmet food around Swan Valley (afternoon)

Tantalise your tastebuds by sampling the finest chocolate, coffee, honey, macarons, nuts, ice cream, cheese, wine, noughtat and pastries. Popular places to visit are:

- Margaret River Chocolate Company – free chocolate samples is the largest in WA
- Yahava Kaffeeworks – free coffee tastings, specialty blends from all over the world
- House of Honey & Windarra Honey – free tastings, with antimicrobial activity (healing properties)
- Maison Saint Honore – French patisserie specialising in macarons, all hand made
- Morish Nuts – free nut tastings in savoury and sweet combinations
- Oggies Ice Creamery – Over 60 flavour, taste them all!
- The Cheese Barrel – Complimentary cheese tastings of 3 – 4 selections, next to wine café
- Oakford Grounds – wide selection of wines, café and restaurant with games for kids
- Mondo Noughtat – free tasting in a relaxed café setting, offering gelato and Italian coffee
- Little Lamont's Express – French pastries, gourmet deli products, wine and coffee
- Providore & Coward & Black – wide range of home made jams, preserves, olive oils & sauces

Pick your own fresh produce straight from the orchard at Core Cider House (apples), Golden Grove Orchard (Citrus), Kien Strawberry Farm, The Fruit Corner (cherries and plums) and Perth Mango Farm. Most orchards sell a variety of fruits and vegetables. Or spend your afternoon/evening on one of the many walking trails in the area to see the best scenic views. The Bells Rapid Walk Trail is popular to see rushing rapids in winter and beautiful boulders. The trail distance is 2.5 – 3kms with an approximate walking time of 45 minutes to 1.5 hours.
